- If selected, scholars will be required to attend a mandatory New Scholar Orientation, all Leadership Development Institute Training Conferences (6 Total / 1 Saturday Per Month), 2 Annual Leadership Development Institute Social Mixers, the Annual Opening Doors Awards Scholarship Ceremony & Benefit Dinner to receive scholar recognition, and the Annual Leadership Development Institute Graduation & Certification Awards Ceremony. Leadership Development Institute Alum that are selected as scholars and serving as Campus Liaisons / Peer Mentors, are also required to attend all 6 Leadership Development Institute Training Conferences (6 Total - 1 Saturday Per Month) to provide peer reinvestment mentoring and support. All applicants will be formally requested to reserve these dates and should plan accordingly so that your schedule will accommodate their attendance for these mandatory requirements of all Best & Brightest Scholars.
- Scholars should understand that the Best & Brightest Scholarship is disbursed in two disbursements, Fall and Spring. Fall disbursements begin processing in December of 2017 after Fall Grades post and MMF verification of student full-time enrollment, minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0, and documented satisfactory participation in the MMF Leadership Development Institute thru December 2017 (As LDI Student or Liaison/Peer Mentor) and Spring Disbursements begin processing in March of 2018 following MMF verification of student full-time enrollment, minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0, documented satisfactory participation and/or graduation from the 2017-2018 Leadership Development Institute (As LDI Student or Liaison/Peer Mentor), completion of Administrative Internship Placement (LDI Alum Applicable), and verification of any other applicable program eligibility requirements being met, as outlined in the 2017-2018 Best & Brightest Scholar Eligibility Criteria. Disbursements are structured in this fashion annually to maximize student academic grade performance, academic enrollment retention, and the extent to which each student couples academic education in the classroom with practical leadership & employment skills training.
- By signing this application, applicant acknowledges that he or she may be "conditionally selected" based upon information submitted in his or her scholarship application and may be recognized as a 2017-2018 Best & Brightest scholar in that regard at the Annual Opening Doors Scholarship Awards Ceremony & Benefit Dinner held in April of 2018 based upon information submitted in his or her scholarship application. However, if it is discovered prior to scholarship disbursement that the applicant fails to maintain a cumulative 3.0 GPA and/or meet other scholarship eligibility requirements during the Fall or Spring Semester (i.e. grade performance, full-time enrollment, satisfactory Leadership Development Institute participation, satisfactory Administrative Internship participation, etc.), that he or she will be deemed ineligible and may not receive the actual scholarship disbursement.
